Removal and replacement: Fuser (duplex models)

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Introduction

This document provides the procedures to remove and replace the fuser for duplex models.

Before you begin

- Turn off the printer.
- Disconnect the power cable.
- **WARNING!** To avoid damage to the printer, turn the printer off, wait 30 seconds, and then remove the power cord before attempting to service the printer.
- Use the table below to identify the correct part number for your printer. To order the part, go to www.hp.com/buy/parts.

Required tools

- #2 Phillips screwdriver with a magnetic tip
- Small flat-blade screwdriver

After performing service

- Connect the power cable.
- Use the power switch to turn the power on.

Step 1: Remove Tray 2

- A Pull the tray out until it stops. Lift the front of the tray, and then pull it out of the printer to remove it.

Step 2: Open the front door and duplexer door

1. Press the button (callout 1) on the left side of the printer to release the front door.

Step 7: Remove the integrated scanner assembly (M377, M477 models)

- NOTE: This step is for the M377, M477 models. For the M452 models, skip this step and go to <u>Step 10:</u> <u>Remove the top cover (M452 models) on page 2060</u>.
 - 1. On the left side of the printer, disconnect three connectors (callout 1).

Step 8: Remove the fax PCA (M477 models)

NOTE: This step is for M477 fax models only. Skip this step for non-fax models.

1. Disconnect one connector (callout 1). Beginning with the top right screw (callout 2) remove four screws (callout 3) in a counterclockwise direction.

 - 1. On the left side of the printer, on the formatter PCA, disconnect two connectors (callout 1).

6. Behind the control panel, remove one screw (callout 1), and then use a small flat-blade screwdriver at two pry points (callout 2) to release the control panel cover from the top cover.

- 9. Remove two screws (callout 1), and then remove one screw (callout 2) and release one ground wire.
 - **Reinstallation tip:** The two screws toward the front of the control panel (callout 1) are longer than the other screw. Make sure these screws are installed in the correct position when reinstalling the part.

10. Carefully lift the control panel away and rest it on the top cover, and then remove one screw (callout 1).

CAUTION: The control panel is still attached to the top cover by the flat cable.

11. Place the control panel back into position. With your hand, refasten the screw (callout 1) that was previously removed from the control panel cover to temporarily reattach the control panel to the top cover. Doing this should protect the flat cable from being damaged.

Step 12: Unpack the replacement part

Remove the new part from its package. Save all packaging for recycling the used part.

For complete information on HP's recycling programs, go to **Product return and recycling**.

NOTE: HP recommends responsible disposal of the defective part.



Step 13: Install the fuser (duplex models)

1. Position the fuser on the printer. When installing the fuser, make sure that the switchback lever (callout 1) is installed completely through the opening (callout 2) in the printer frame.

1. Position the end of the roller into the slot in the printer (callout 1). It might be necessary to rotate the roller until it fits correctly into the slot. Press down on the left side of the roller (callout 2) until it snaps into place.

4. Return the printer to an upright position so that the bottom side is down.

Step 5: Install Tray 3

• With the front of the tray slightly lifted, align the sides of the tray with the rails in the feeder, and then carefully slide the tray into the feeder. As the tray slides into the feeder, lower the front of the tray, and then close it.
